Our aim is to provide high quality care and treatment in a relaxed, comfortable and safe environment. We are committed to continuing education and keeping abreast of advances in modern dentistry. To ensure we maintain the high standards our patients have come to expect it is becoming increasingly important for us to accurately match the number and the needs of our patients to the resources we have available.

Research shows that preventive dentistry delivered on a regular basis greatly reduces the risk of dental disease and provides a platform for a lifetime of improved oral health. We encourage such an approach and with this in mind, we have joined with **Patient Plan** to design a dental plan to reward loyal patients. This plan will be administered by **Patient Plan** who will make a separate arrangement with you to manage your payments under the plan. The plan will provide advantages both to you and to us. It will allow us to plan your dental care more effectively and provide the best chance of keeping you dentally fit. The advantage for you is that it should reduce the need for future treatment and you will have the peace of mind that all of your preventive dental care will be covered by convenient monthly payments. Our plan also provides worldwide Supplementary Insurance for dental emergencies or dental injuries whilst at home or abroad (see overleaf).



About Us

- Your dental examination and hygiene visits are included
- Payment by convenient monthly Direct Debit, allowing you to budget or once off annual payment to allow you to receive same day treatment from the practice
- Guaranteed registration with the practice and continuing access to your dentist
- No need for an assessment – you can join immediately
- Early identification of dental problems to prevent pain, discomfort and inconvenience
- Appointment times to suit you whenever possible.
- Priority booking in the event of a dental emergency

Who is our plan for?

Our plan is designed for patients who wish to attend the practice on a regular basis and have peace of mind that their preventive dental care is covered.

What does our plan include?

Our Dental Plans cost from £28.00 per month and cover:

- Two hygiene appointments per year including scale and polish and periodontal advice
- Two dental health examinations per year
- Up to four bite wing or periapical x-rays per year (Subject to clinical requirement)
- Routine oral cancer screening
- Diet and oral hygiene advice
- Global Accident and Emergency Scheme (see overleaf).

The monthly plan cost includes the charges for management and administration payable by you to Patient Plan. Treatment not covered by this plan must be paid for separately.

How do you join our plan?

There is no need for an assessment. Joining is very simple. All you have to do is complete a registration form for us and a Direct Debit mandate and authorisation form for Patient Plan. In addition to your first monthly payment, an initial registration fee of £10 per person will be payable by you to Patient Plan and will be included in your first Direct Debit payment. If you choose to leave the plan for any reason you can do so by simply giving the practice one month's notice. Please call the practice to discuss a cancellation date prior to cancelling your direct debit.

Who is our plan for?

Your Global Dental Scheme

(See patient Information summary)

- ✓ Cover for:
 - up to £20,000 worth of treatment following dental injury
 - temporary emergency treatment whilst away from home in the UK or abroad (up to £920 per year)
- ✓ The callout fee charged by a dentist opening their surgery to treat you in an emergency (max £200 per year)
- ✓ Hospital benefit if you are admitted to a hospital as an inpatient under the care of a consultant specialising in dental or maxillofacial surgery (£70 per night)
- ✓ Benefit if diagnosed with Oral Cancer (£2,500)
- ✓ 24 hour access to a worldwide emergency helpline

The Supplementary Insurance is designed to cover the cost of **temporary emergency treatment whilst you are more than 25 miles away from your registered dentist, when you are away from home.**

You must cover the first £15 of any call-out fee.
